VMCCA Mountains and Plains Regional tour July 29-30, 2017 Leadville, CO

Please join your fellow Mountains and Plains regional members for a simple weekend overnight tour to Leadville, CO. Although your old car is encouraged, we completely understand if you can't bring yours because of the elevation. We really just want you to join us in person!

We start off with a ride on the **Leadville Colorado and Southern Railway Wildflower Special train**. See the alpine flowers at their peak, splashing the mountain with vibrant color! Join experienced tour guides for a 20-minute walk through pine forests, aspen groves, and open meadows. View a multitude of wildflowers at the water tower, including Indian Paintbrush, Lupine, and wild strawberries. Remember to bring your walking/hiking shoes, a water bottle, and a camera. This hike is for people of all capabilities and interests and is a perfect opportunity to view the mountain scenery at its peak! The train departs at **10:00 am** and arrive back at the depot at **1:00 pm**. A catered boxed lunch will be provided on the train.

Saturday afternoon will be open for each person to visit the sights, shops and antique stores of downtown Leadville! You may schedule your own tour or visit of one of many sights including the **Tabor Opera House**, the **National Mining Hall of Fame and Museum**, or the **Baxter cabin**.

Dinner is arranged at **Quincy's Steakhouse** at **6:30pm**. 416 Harrison Ave Leadville, CO. We have a private room with space to have our annual meeting afterward. Dinner options are listed below and include baked potato; wedge salad with specialty house dressing; and soft, sweet bakery bread. Drinks are not included, but a full bar is available. Please make your selection on the second page of this form.

The regional meeting will be held after dinner at approximately **8:00 pm** at **Quincy's Steakhouse**. All are welcome and encouraged to join.

Take a drive over one of the scenic byways at the top of the Rockies! **Tennessee Pass to Minturn** is open and beautiful and has near it **Camp Hale**, the training grounds for the **Army 10th Mountain Division**. **Independence Pass** is open for a spectacular trip to **Aspen**. **Fremont Pass** returns from Leadville to I-70 in **Copper Mountain**. The options are endless!
