The vehicle has a fire extinguisher of adequate size, rated for at least B&C and bearing the UL and/or OSHA seals of approval. All headlamps, turn signals and tail lamps must be in working order. All braking systems of the vehicle are in good working order and will stop the vehicle within the limits prescribed by the manufacturer at the time it was produced. The steering mechanism is functional and within the limits of the vehicle's performance when new.
